Communication

Attendance

- Only 3 unexcused absences per 9-week term before suspension
- All excused absences (Dr. appt., school activity, etc.) must be called into the Center at 772-257-5400
- Students who will be absent due to sports or work must call the center and inform the staff of their upcoming schedule on the Friday <u>before</u> they will be absent.
- Crossover has a waiting list. If your child is suspended from the program because of unexcused absences, they will be placed on the waiting list to rejoin the program.

Behavior

- Students may **not** leave the Center at any time unless picked up by a parent or guardian
- Phones and earbuds will be collected before tutoring begins (may be stored in backpacks)
- Bullying or intentional destruction of personal property will result in immediate suspension
- Students must be respectful to all adults, including staff members and volunteers

Dress Code

- No hoodies or hats on your head inside the building
- No personal headphones or earbuds inside the building during tutoring sessions
- Basketball shoes are required

Parent Financial Responsibility

• If you sign your child up for an activity, you will be responsible for the full cost of that activity if the student does not show up (for example: Basketball camp fee to Crossover is \$100. Parents are asked to contribute \$10. If your child does not show up, you will owe the full amount of \$100.

High School Days

• If your student plans on staying longer than their designated time, then they MUST volunteer. They will either volunteer to tutor a student or work off the designated list of volunteer activities. If they are volunteering to be an academic mentor, they MUST connect with Mia Morin to complete the volunteer training requirements before they are eligible to mentor.

Pick-Up and Academic Mentoring Days at Crossover Center

High School: Everyday Monday-Thursday. Crossover will pick up at Vero Beach High School and Sebastian River High School daily.

Middle School: Middle school students will attend twice per week on either Monday & Wednesday *OR* Tuesday & Thursday, depending on which school they attend.

Monday & Wednesday: Crossover will pick up at Gifford Middle School and Oslo Middle School

Tuesday & Thursday: Crossover will pick up at Storm Grove Middle, Sebastian Middle School, and Sebastian Charter Middle School

Elementary School: Everyday Monday-Thursday. Elementary school students will need to provide their own transportation.

All private school and home school students will attend on Tuesdays and Thursdays, regardless of grade level.
