HOME COURT ADVANTAGE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN OVERVIEW

Crossover Mission launched its first capital campaign in January 2022 in conjunction with the purchase of a former citrus packing facility located near the community of Gifford. The goals of this *Home Court Advantage* Capital Campaign include:

- ➔ Renovate a 40,000 square foot building to deliver athletic, academic, college and career preparedness, nutrition and community programming for underserved youth from Indian River County.
- ➔ Upgrade the grounds to improve pedestrian and vehicle access, lighting, security, signage, landscape and drainage.
- ➔ Retire the mortgage to wholly own our property.
- ➔ Establish a permanent endowment to ensure financial strength.
